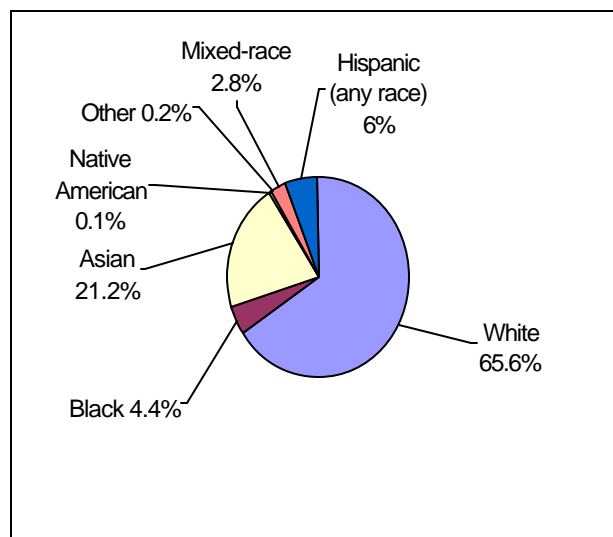


# Skokie 2000 Census Fact Sheet

## General

- Skokie is a growing community! Total Population: 63,348 (+6.6% from 1990)
- Skokie is the 12<sup>th</sup> largest municipality in Northeast Illinois and the 18<sup>th</sup> largest in the state.
- Skokie's median age is 41.9 and has remained about the same for the last 20 years.
- Skokie has 15,987 residents under age 20 and 12,386 residents over age 64.

## Diversity

Skokie is one of the most diverse communities in the state (not adjusted for Hispanic ethnicity).

- Skokie Hispanics are most likely to be from Central or South America, followed by Mexico, Puerto Rico, and Cuba.

## Households

- Total housing units: 23,702
- Average household size: 2.68 people
- Average family size: 3.20 people
- 75.2% of units are owner occupied, 24.8% of units are renter occupied.
- Only 2.0% of homes in Skokie are vacant.
- There are 17,044 families in Skokie.
- 4.2% of households are headed by single moms.
- 5,492 people live alone. 3,147 of these people are 65 years old or older.
- 6,047 adult children live with at least 1 parent.
- Median home value: \$235,000 (Q2 2001)
